Wool Punches - Troubleshooting

- 1. Punches must be used on a really hard and stable surface.
- Incomplete or partial circles occur when the weight is not distributed over the surface of the punch equally.
 To resolve this, move your hand as far to the base of the punch as possible. This forces you to distribute equal weight over the cutting surface of the punch.
- 3. The amount of times you need to strike the punch will depend on two things your strength and the weight of the mallet.
- 4. A rawhide or synthetic (plastic/nylon) weighted mallet between 16-24oz is recommended.
